July 30th & Aug 6th – Bathroom cleaner

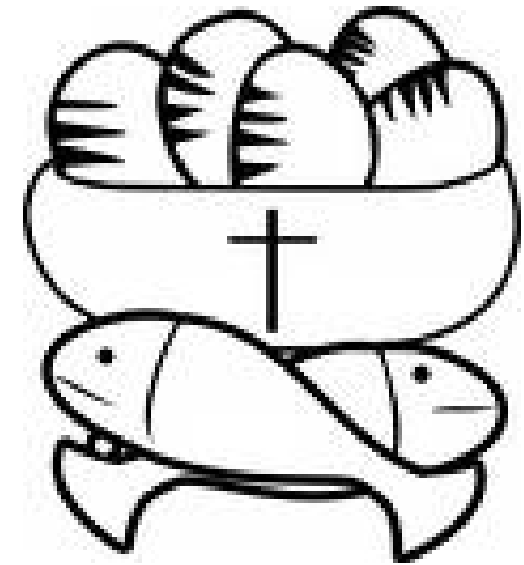
Items will be delivered to Canterbury College next week so baskets can be assembled.
