This is just a reminder that the Diocese of Huron policy regarding intinction or dipping of the Eucharistic host into the chalice is that it is not permitted. If you have any questions as to the why or justification for this established policy, please see Rev'd Paul or pick up a information booklet at the greeter's desk in the foyer.

For those who chose to receive just one of the Body or the Blood of Christ, that is considered to be full participation in the Eucharist according to our tradition. We typically do receive both when we come to the table, but receiving just one is fully acceptable as well.
