**DEANERY PRESENTATION** on the “*United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples*” will be held at St. Mark's by the Lake (150 St. Mark's Rd, Tecumseh) on Tuesday, Oct 24<sup>th</sup> at 7pm. This event will be led by Rev. Rosalyn Elm and is a follow up to the Blanket Exercises which were held earlier in the year. We will learn about the UN Declaration of the Rights of Indigenous Peoples, its place in our common life and ways for us to live according to its principles, norms and standards.

## WHO WAS ST. AUGUSTINE?

Augustine of Canterbury was a missionary bishop considered the “Apostle to the English” and revered as a saint. He was sent with a team of 40 monks to re-introduce Christianity to England and was welcomed by King Aethelberht of Kent. As the first Archbishop of Canterbury from 597 to 604 A.D. much is known about Augustine's life and work. His traditional feast day is May 26<sup>th</sup> (BCP), the date of his death. Augustine is considered the founder of *The King's School, Canterbury* – the world's oldest existing school.

Augustine expanded the church rapidly; he organized much missionary work and converted many to Christianity, including thousands during a mass baptism on Christmas Day in 597.

The name “St. Augustine of Canterbury” was chosen by parishioners as the name for our new parish in October 2012.
