Today is the final day to register, raffle tickets will be available this week and next. Please speak with Dawn or Jane.

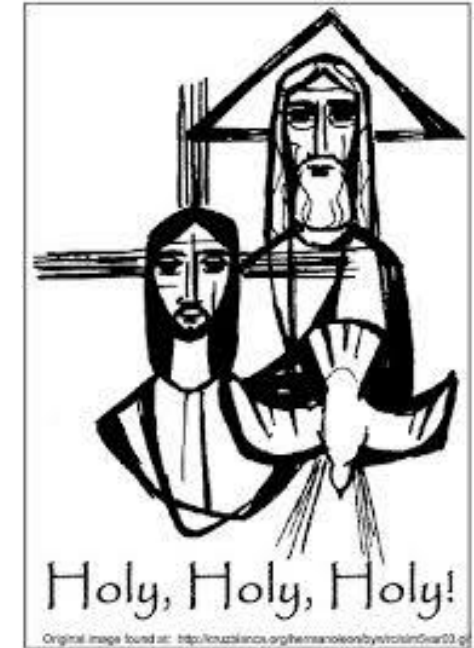
