Since the beginning of Lent we have been collecting items and donations to send to our friends in Kingfisher Lake. Although we have yet to reach our goal, we are almost there.

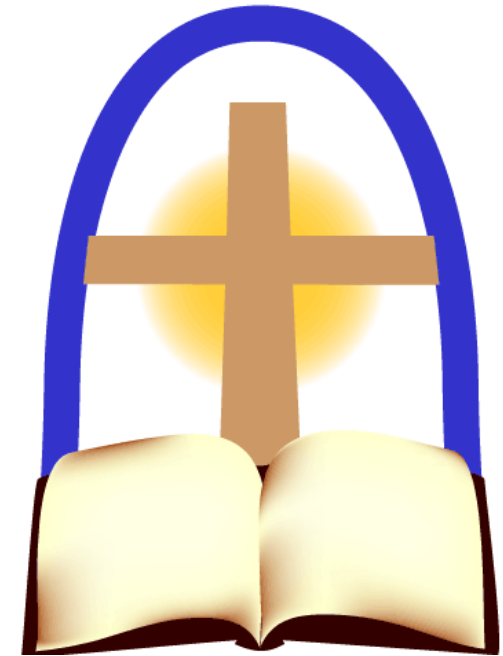
