DEANERY CONVERSATIONS on the proposed changes to the Marriage Canon will be held at St. James' Roseland (4276 Roseland Dr E) will be held on Tuesday, Jan 16th at 7pm. Every Diocese in the Anglican Church of Canada has been asked by General Synod in 2016 to engage their communities in conversation around the proposed changes to the Marriage Canon prior to the final vote on proposed changes scheduled for General Synod 2019.
